#### APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES

#### EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR REPORT

Acting Executive Director Hatcher introduced non-voting member James Hock, Chief of Staff, Maryland State Police. The ATC has received permission to hire a contractual employee to assist the Commissioners. The Commissioners were asked to reach out to Acting Executive Director Hatcher regarding skills and qualifications they are looking for in a candidate.

Chair Foxwell announced his resignation.

#### OVERVIEW OF MARYLAND TOBACCO LAWS AND REGULATIONS

Chair Foxwell introduced Acting Executive Director Hatcher, FEB Director Kelly, and Kathleen Hoke, Director of the Center for Tobacco Regulation, University of Maryland Carey School of law.

Acting Executive Director Hatcher gave a presentation on the distribution of tobacco products in Maryland.

Kathleen Hoke gave a presentation on the Food and Drug Administration regulation of tobacco products.

Commissioner Morrissette left the meeting at 3:20 p.m.

#### 2021 MARYLAND GENERAL ASSEMBLY UPDATE

Acting Executive Director Hatcher addressed the following statewide bills that are actively moving.

- SB 883 Creates a new section of law for Business Regulation, Title 16.9 for out of state sales of premium cigars and pipe tobacco.
- HB 12 Delivery of product from an off-premise location.
- HB 185 Passed the House and crossed over to the Senate. Prohibits the requirement of a customer purchasing one drink upon entering an establishment.
- HB 422 Moved to the Senate. This a study to determine and evaluate minority participation in the alcoholic beverages industry.

#### **NEW BUSINESS**

Chair Foxwell turned over to Murray Singerman. Robert's Rules of Orders conflicts with the Open Meetings Act. His suggestion is to discuss this and come up with suggestions on how to have a base on which to operate to have compliance with the Open Meetings Act. Add it as an agenda item for the next meeting and come up with specific suggestions. Motioned by Commissioner Wahl, seconded by Commissioner Buck. Motion passed.
