TO: Non-Resident Dealer Permit Holders for Wine and Distilled Spirits

**SUBJECT: Revised Regulation** 

On March 1, 1997, revised Regulation # 03.02.01.12 concerning wine and distilled spirits distributorship appointments will take effect. The major purpose of this amendment is to alter the amount of time required for a change of distributorship to 30 days and to provide for orderly changes in distributorship of wine and distilled spirits brands.
