Subject: Alcoholic Beverage Trade Practice Regulations

This office is in the process of reviewing and amending regulations found under Alcoholic Beverage Trade Practices - COMAR 03.02.05.

On July 15, 2008, we held an open forum with various sectors of the industry in an effort to provide the industry with an opportunity to voice operational questions, and to discuss any changes to be made to the Trade Practice Regulations – COMAR 03.02.05. Many of you attended the meeting in Annapolis. The results have been reviewed by staff and are posted to the MATT Regulatory Division's website. Those formal regulatory amendments should appear in the Maryland Register issued by the Division of State Documents sometime in October 2008.
