## INFORMATION AND TRAINING ADVISORY 24-006

### **Inspections of License and Permit Holders/Premises**

This advisory serves as notice that the Office of the Executive Director's (OED) Trade Practices Unit will begin conducting inspections, announced and unannounced, of licensed and/or permitted entities. These entities include, but are not limited to, manufacturers, wholesalers, and caterers. The goal of these inspections is to encourage compliance through education and proactive efforts.

Each entity, as a condition of obtaining a license or permit, agrees to conform to all the laws, rules, and regulations of the State of Maryland and local jurisdictions, as appropriate, relating to the license or permit they hold including review of any required records and inspection of all licensed/permitted areas upon demand by an authorized OED employee.

License and permit holders can expect to be asked to provide complete and accurate records of all alcoholic beverages and tobacco products purchased, sold, manufactured, rectified, blended, improved, brewed, fermented, distilled, produced, stored, warehoused, withdrawn from storage, imported, or transferred.
